## REGULATION 14 CONSULTATION ON PRE-SUBMISSION VERSION OF TETSWORTH NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN

As Tetsworth residents and others with an interest in the Neighbourhood Area, you are invited to review and comment on the Pre-Submission version of Tetsworth's Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP) which has been undergoing review. 
