

Thank you for the opportunity to provide an overview of local policing activity for Tetsworth. Unfortunately, we are unable to attend the meeting on 13 May. In our absence, please find below an overview covering the period 1 April 2025 to 1 April 2026.

Overall, reported crime levels remain relatively stable at 111 compared to last year (105), with no identified burglary offences and no emerging patterns indicating increased risk across the wider parish area. Details are available on TVP's website.

Resourcing

The Thame Neighbourhood Policing Team currently consists of:

- 3 Neighbourhood Police Constables, working across a single shift pattern
- The team works under the Thame & Henley Sergeant and closely with neighbouring neighbourhood teams across Oxfordshire
- The team will soon be strengthened by the addition of 2 Police Community Support Officers (PCSOs)
- The team also covers the parishes of Thame, Chalgrove, Chinnor, Stadhampton, Tetsworth, Watlington, and Wheatley
- The neighbourhood team focuses on longer term problem solving, while also providing initial responses to live incidents and supporting Response teams as required

Response policing is provided by officers working across Oxfordshire from various stations, ensuring 24/7 emergency coverage.
